COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to meet the training needs of the ICT4. It is presented in a discussion/exercise format. The six instructional units cover: Foundation Skills; Intelligence Gathering and Documentation; Size Up the Incident; Develop a Plan of Action; Post-fire Activities; Evaluating Incident Objectives and Manage the Incident. Student will be evaluated by unit tests and performance.

- Gather and document essential information
- Size up the incident, develop plan of action.
- Manage the incident through effective leadership.
- Evaluate plan of action and make adjustments when necessary.
- Conduct post fire activities.
